								Objectives / Purposes: Artificial Intelligence (AI) is a current topic of much interest. Most research shows this area of technology has a definite and dramatic impact to the world. Robotic Arm extends the application of AI to address real world physical problems. In fact, AI requires the use of advanced mathematics. Usually we need a good foundation on mathematical training. However, due to computer programming becoming more common in the education environment, we can demonstrate the function and power to student by first following examples; i.e. we can play with AI. This can stimulate participants and they would independently develop their own interest on AI topics. Robotic arms give them a chance to apply their AI knowledge for robotic automation. In the first part of the program, students will learn to appreciate the current state-of-the-art in AI and its on-going developments. Further, students are to experience AI by actually working with various development tools such as "Teachable Machine", ChatGPT and "App Inventor". After the program, they will be equipped with skills to build machine learning models, develop recognition and systhesis		
								applications which can be readily deployed in mobile devices. In the second part, students' skills and knowledge are developed from scratch with no prior assumption. Methodically, we lead the students to understand, build, test and operate a model robotic arm step-by-step. During the process, students will learn how to use a simulator to create and test their applications. In addition, the students will be taught how to use a Java platform to develop a rich graphical user interface (GUI) for their applications. They will also be instructed on how to apply the concept of Inverse Kinematics for implementation on a Java emulator platform. Finally, the students are to assemble their own robotic arm and connect them to a control module for testing as well as manual and automatic operations. Simple robotic arm system projects will also be attempted to illustrate typical real-world application scenarios.
