

Scholarship Scheme for Outstanding Performance and Contribution in Music at HKUGA College (2026-2027)

I. Introduction

The scholarship scheme is designed to recognize and support students who have demonstrated exceptional commitment, perseverance, and contributions to their music teams. This esteemed program aims to honor those individuals who have exhibited unwavering dedication to their musical pursuits. As a testament to their outstanding talent and tireless efforts, selected students will receive a portion of their tuition fees as a token of appreciation. Through this scholarship, we seek to foster the growth and development of our talented musicians, encouraging them to continue their journey with passion and resilience within our vibrant music community.

II. The Music Scholarship Scheme

Students can receive a scholarship ranging from 25% to 100% of one year's tuition fees upon demonstration of outstanding music achievements in musical examinations and competitions organized by reputable organizations, as well as executive leadership skills in making contributions to the development of music teams.

III. Basic Requirements

1. The applicants' attitude, initiative, sense of responsibility, and commitment will be considered.
2. Their academic results should be satisfactory.
3. Good conduct would be assessed by Heads of Years (HOYs) and the commendable attitude would be assessed by the teacher in charge or conductor of the designated team.
4. **Eligible students must be enrolled at HKUGA College for 2026–2027 and have belonged to a music school team in 2025–2026 that competed in a credible local competition.**

*All students who fulfill the basic requirements may apply for the music scholarship, regardless of whether they have benefitted from other financial assistance.

IV. Formation of the Music Scholarship Vetting Board

The Awards, Scholarship & Financial Support Committee would act as the vetting committee of the Music Scholarship.

V. Criteria for the Music Scholarship

The criteria for the music scholarship consist of five parts, namely '***Part A: Results of Practical Examination from a Recognized Institute***', '***Part B: Leadership Roles of Music School Teams***', '***Part C: Individual Outstanding Achievements***', '***Part D:***

Contribution to the Music Development of the School’, and ‘Part E: Nominations from Respective HOY and Conductors’.

VI. How to apply for the Music Scholarship

1. Students need to fill in all mandatory entries of the google form on or before **Sep 4, 2026 (Fri)**. In the google form, applicants are required to fill in their basic information, as well as to write invitation notes for their Head of Year (HOY) and conductors of school teams for nomination.
2. All applications will be verified and sent to respective HOY and conductors for nomination.
3. The Head of Aesthetics will verify the application and finalize the score upon receiving the complete applications.
4. Students may be asked to attend an interview as part of the vetting process. 25-100% of school fees may be waived depending on the student’s performance. The talent scholarship board will make the final decision based on the consultation of the Music Scholarship Board.
5. **Students who receive the music scholarship are obligated to join at least one of the music school teams in the coming year upon the recommendation of the Head of Aesthetics.**
